To make sure your costume is eligible for a prize, you must follow these guidelines:

- 2. The only materials you can use in the construction of the costume are paper

(notebook, typing, newspaper), cardboard and tape (duct tape, scotch tape, masking tape).

- 3. You may use paint, crayons or markers to cover the costume and give it a design and color. NO OTHER type of décor materials may be used.
- 4. Your hero must be your original creation (no Batmans, Wonder Womans, Supermans, etc.).
- 5. Submit the following information on an index card. On one side, write the hero's name and a 1-sentence description of him/her. On the other side, include the following: Name
